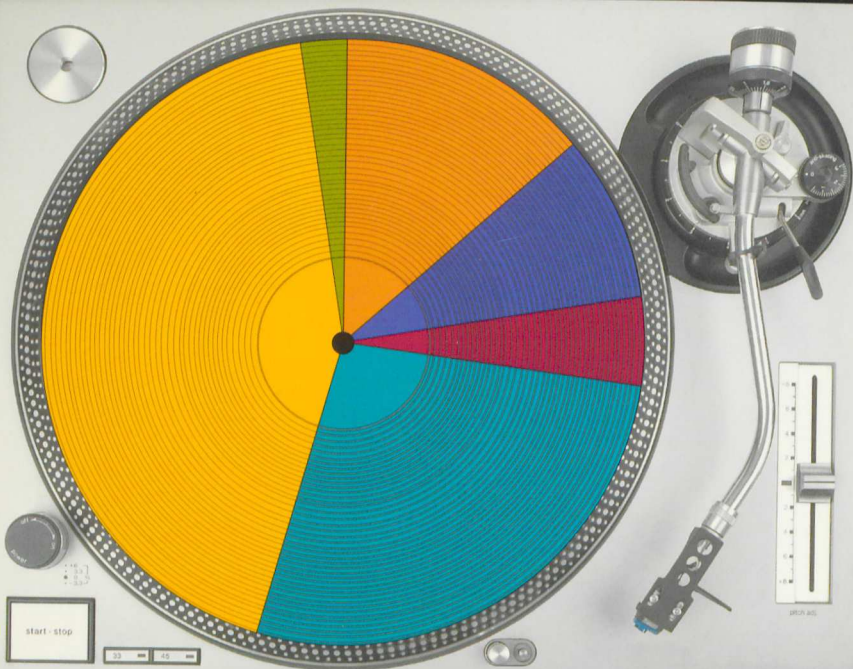

The nonprofit group Future of Music Coalition has launched Artist Revenue Streams, a multi-method research initiative to assess if and how musicians' revenue streams are changing in this new music landscape.

The project includes: in-depth interviews with more than 25 different types of musicians -- from jazz performers, to classical players, TV and film composers, Nashville songwriters, rockers and hip hop artists; financial snapshots that will show individual artists' revenue pies in any given year; and a wide ranging online survey in which we hope thousands of musicians will participate in fall 2011.
